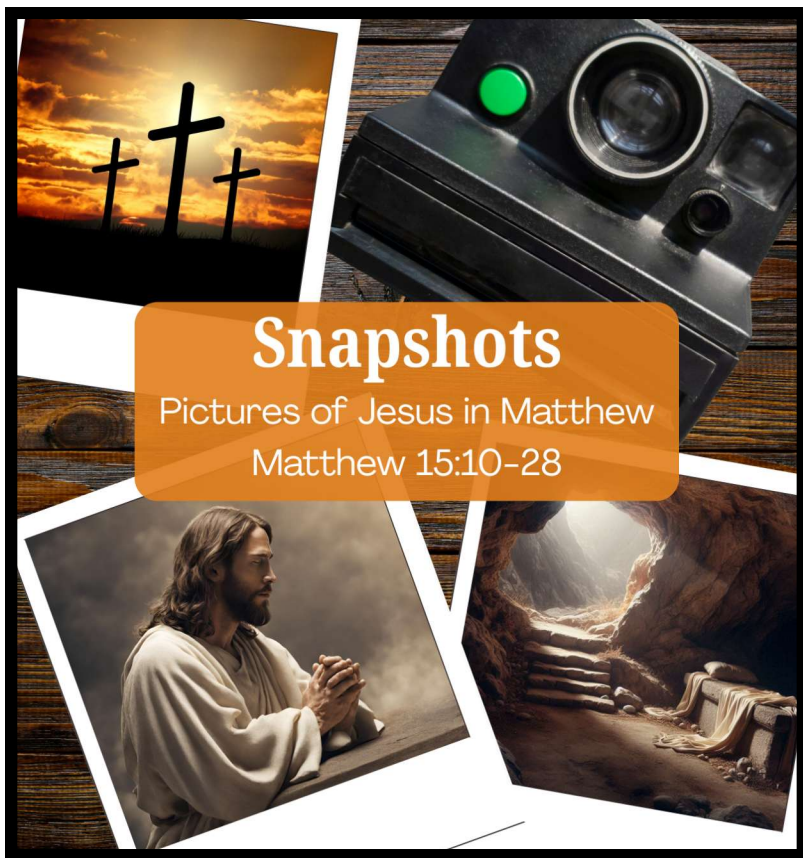

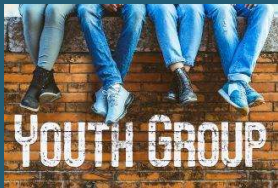

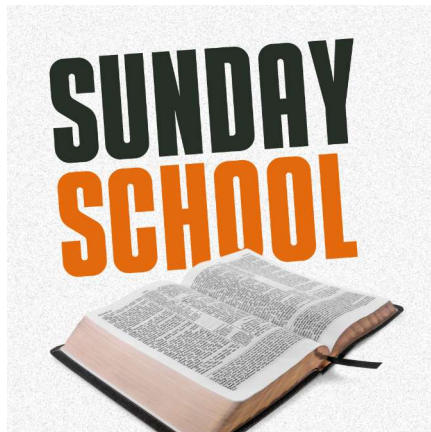
Sunday School Classes - Spotlight

Sunday School meets each Sunday from 9:00–10:00 AM.

We invite you to visit a class and find a place to connect, grow, and belong.

Find the class that's right for you — all are welcome!

- **Journey with Jesus** (Room 201)
Designed for adults approximately ages 23–55, this class offers a welcoming, engaging, and fun environment for spiritual growth and community building. Through biblical teaching and meaningful discussion, participants are encouraged to grow in faith, connect with others, and make a positive impact in the community. No matter where you are on your spiritual journey, you are welcome here.
- **The Inquirer's** (Room 206)
A discussion-based Bible study class focused on both the Old and New Testaments. Members share personal experiences, explore biblical principles for everyday Christian living, and enjoy thoughtful conversation each week. New ideas and open discussion are always encouraged.
- **Maranatha** (Room 207)
A small-group class using studies from RightNow Media featuring speakers such as Max Lucado, Francis Chan, and Lisa Harper. Lessons focus on understanding Scripture and applying biblical truths to everyday life.
- **Unbroken Circle** (Room 203)
Geared toward older adults, though all ages are warmly welcomed. This Bible-based class takes a deeper look at Scripture and explores how God's Word speaks into daily living and faithful discipleship.
