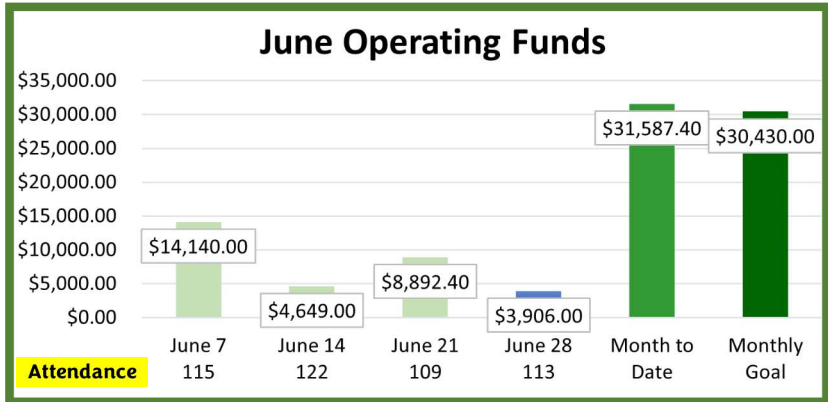
To help us keep church communications organized and accurate, **all requests** (Announcements, News, Website, Journal, or Email updates) must include a completed Communication Request Form.

Exploring Bible Study Methods

There is no “one-size-fits-all” approach to Bible study. Different methods – such as GPA, SOAP, verse mapping, journaling, and more – can help deepen our understanding of God’s Word. One study method often referenced by Payton is the GPA Method: God, People, and Application. This simple three-step framework helps readers discover who God is, learn from the people in the passage, and apply Scripture to daily life. Below is a simple example of this study method for you to try.

SOAP Method

Scripture

Write out a verse or passage that stands out to you.

Observation

What do you notice about the passage? What is happening? What stands out?

Application

How does this Scripture apply to your life today?

Prayer

Write a short prayer asking God to help you live out what you learned.

GPA Method

G – God (What does this reveal about God?)

- **Ask:** What attributes of God are displayed?
What is He doing in this passage?
- **Action:** Write down His names, titles, or any commands, promises, and truths revealed about Him.

P – People (What does this reveal about people?)

- **Ask:** Who are the main individuals or groups?
What are their reactions, emotions, and decisions?
- **Action:** Identify human nature at work, including any sins to avoid, examples to follow, or relational dynamics to note.

A – Application (How do I respond?)

- **Ask:** How does this truth impact my life today?
What specific change do I need to make?
- **Action:** Keep your application personal, practical, measurable, and provable. Write a short “I will...” statement.
