DISASTER RECOVERY

Recent weather disasters in the Houston area are proving to be an opportunity for us to serve. We are currently planning on joining Georgetown UMC on a mission trip to Conroe, north of Houston. **July 18 - 21. This 4-day trip includes travel time.**

The work includes mucking out houses, removing drywall and insulation, removing furniture, and mold mitigation due to flooding in the recent storms. Accommodation is provided for us, and we'll provide and cook our meals. TAI CHI MONDAYS & WEDNESDAYS



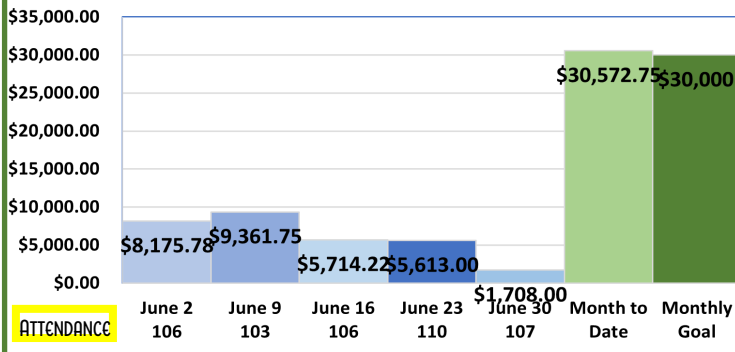
Classes start this Monday at 1pm in the gym.

Health Tips in the Wesleyan Tradition

Stress

What can stress do to yourbody?

Stress can effect all parts of your body and cause mental and physical changes.

This week it's the Heart

Acute stress of short duration can cause what we now call "broken heart syndrome

It can be physical like a fever, seizure or emotional such as fear or grief.

Symptoms can be irregular heartbeat, hyperventilating or even fainting.
Chronic stress of long duration, called the "silent killer." Blood vessels tighten & constrict reducing oxygen to the heart & increases blood pressure.

High blood pressure is the #1 risk factor for heart disease & stroke.
