

Health Tips in the Wesleyan Tradition

Stress Yes, we're talking about it again

Stress can effect all parts of your body and cause mental and physical changes.

In the next few weeks the areas of the concern will be highlighted. This week it's the

BRAIN.

Stress initiates in the brain, triggered by external factors like an alarm clock. This stress can be brief or prolonged, prompting the body to release chemicals for the fight or flight response. Even though you tackle your stressful job daily, you can't fight or flee as you need your paycheck. Consequently, these chemicals harm your body since they can't perform their intended function, leading to chronic stress.
