#### Health Tips in the Wesleyan Tradition

Defibrillators Save Lives

If someone suffers from cardiac arrest in a public place, it's advisable to locate an automated external defibrillator (AED), even if an ambulance is nearby. A recent study of Danish data revealed that using a defibrillator increased the chances of survival for cardiac arrest victims when paramedics arrived after two minutes. While regulations differ by state, many public areas like community centers, gyms, and airports are legally mandated to have AEDs. Although not mandatory in all workplaces and buildings, investing in these devices, which typically cost between \$1500 to \$2500, could potentially save lives.

We have an AED in each building. Thanks to generous benefactors.


